Description

Deletes an array element or elements that contain a specified substring regardless of case.

When an element is deleted, ColdFusion recalculates index positions.

substring	string	Yes	2		A string or a variable that contains one. The search is not case-sensitive.
scope	string	false	3	one	one: replaces the first occurrence. all: replaces all occurrences.
